Catering

The Undercroft café is open Monday to Friday 10.00am to 2.00pm. We also host receptions, dinners, conferences, lectures and film nights, all supported by our catering team. There are opportunities for volunteers to help at all of these by preparing, serving and hosting. Training (may be accredited) will be given.

Event support

Our church is the venue for a wide variety of public events and concerts, including during the Edinburgh Fringe Festival. There are volunteering opportunities to help with set-up – some physical strength needed for this – with technicals such as light and sound, and with front of house activities.

Music

Music is central to our life at St Andrew's and St George's West, and we welcome new participants with relevant skills. For the choir, singers are expected to have good sight-reading ability; for bell-ringing, beginners to peal-ringers are welcome.

Christian Aid Sale

We need volunteers to help with sorting books and other items for our Christian Aid Book Sale in May. Specialist knowledge is helpful, but there are opportunities for anyone with plenty of stamina.

Print and digital media

There are opportunities for volunteer help with design, photography, reporting, social media, print and online publicity. Volunteers can use design skills in event publicity, in publishing our monthly magazine, and in helping to create content for our web, Twitter + Facebook accounts.
